Some say the "secrets" of karate have been lost over the generations. But **Tony Annesi** has devoted decades to discovering the foundations of the fighting arts. Students and instructors alike will benefit tremendously from Kyoshi's depth of understanding and renown teaching skills. A teacher for almost 50 years, Annesi holds black belts in karate, judo and aiki-jujutsu. Must be at least ten years of age to attend.

Can kata really teach you self-defense? Kyoshi Annesi will build on the foundations he presented in the first session and will dig into the intricate moves of several black belt kata such as Basai and WonKon. Hint: they incorporate grappling, throwing and pressure point attacks. You don't have to know these forms to benefit from a fascinating look at the original "bunkai" of these ancient patterns. Recommended for brown and black belts but anyone is welcome.
